Why is our prison ministry so important?

Diary usage

- The diaries are given out in the first 24 hours of an inmate's arrivaleven in centres, people come with almost nothing so are grateful to receive the diary.
- Given out in "goody bags" at Christmas
- Prisoners use them to store phone numbers and appointments in; also they are used to look up the 'verse for the day' on the day of their birthday or the day of their release.
- Prisoners use them for everyday information and keep them in their pockets because they feel that their personal information is then safe
- When prisoners reoffend the first thing they will ask for when they return to prison is a DayOne diary.
- Even the prison staff use them to keep work rotas in!

What a lot of diaries!!



The Diaries and calendars are now in the warehouse – this is part of the delivery that came in a few weeks ago.

195,000 diaries were

delivered and nearly all of them will be going into the hands of prisoners this Christmas time and early in the New Year. Please pray for this side of the work – the diary has a verse from God's Word for each day. That means during the year over 190,000 men, women and youth offenders will be able to read a verse from the Bible.

That could mean that over 69 ½ million times each year a passage from the Bible will be read by people in prisons up and down the UK.

Please do continue to support this work and pray with us that, again this coming year, people will be changed by the power of God's Word.

The Data Protection Act will now be known as the General Data Protection Regulation and as a result DayOne must inform you how we store your personal information that you have supplied to us. This information is stored on a computer that is encrypted and password protected and only accessed by staff as needed on your behalf. All paper copies of your details are destroyed as soon as they are no longer needed. Your information will not be sold to or passed onto any third party. It will be solely used to contact you with information directly relevant to your involvement with DayOne. If you have any issue with how your information is stored or no longer want your information to be stored you can contact DayOne using the details on the form.
