Diary usage

The diaries are given out to inmate's on their arrival. People come with almost nothing so are grateful to receive the diary.

- Given out in "goody bags" at Christmas.
- Prisoners use them to store phone numbers and appointments in; also they are used to look up the 'verse for the day' on the day of their birthday or the day of their release.
- Prisoners use them for everyday information and keep them in their pockets because they feel that their personal information is then safe.
- When prisoners reoffend the first thing they will ask for when they return to prison is a DayOne diary.
- Even the prison staff use them to keep work rotas in!

What a lot of diaries!!



The Diaries and calendars come into the warehouse in September—this is part of the delivery that came in last year.

Nearly 195,000 diaries were

delivered and nearly all of them will be going into the hands of prisoners this Christmas time and early in the New Year.

Please pray for this work – the diary has a verse from God's

Word for each day. That means during the year over 195,000 men, women and youth offenders will be able to read a verse from the Bible.
